## Year 2 visit to Brunel's SS Great Britain

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to let you know about an exciting visit for Year 2 to Brunel's SS Great Britain on Wednesday 17 June. This trip will support our current history topic, Bridges, Boats and Bristol, and will give the children the chance to explore one of the city's most famous landmarks.

We will leave school shortly after registration and travel by coach, returning before the end of the normal school day. Children should wear school uniform with comfortable shoes and bring a waterproof coat. They will also need a named water bottle and a packed lunch in a disposable bag. Children who receive free school meals can order a packed lunch from the school kitchen.

The voluntary contribution for the visit is £5.00 per child, which helps cover coach travel and admission. Please make payment through the school office by Friday 5 June.
